The beginning of the 2025 PST Lake Season is now upon us. Those changes include the replacement of the north road bridge over the Shiawassee River, the dredging of the Hidden Lake channel, the potential dredging of the Landings Way channel and the replacement of the motor and PLC at the Linden dam. All of this in addition to the normal construction projects that seem to increase yearly.
